After more than eleven years spent running from law enforcement, and living as an international fugitive, Rebecca Rubin, a Canadian citizen, surrendered to authorities at the Canada-Washington State border for numerous arsons committed over a five year period. Rubin, who committed the arsons in the name of animal and eco-rights, belonged to a domestic terrorist cell which called itself "The Family" and was responsible for more than \$45 million



dollars in damages, resulting from vandalism and arson.

The group's worst act was the 1998 destruction of a ski resort, the damage of which was estimated to be in excess of \$24 million. Because of the organized nature of this arsonist group, the FBI condensed the investigation of multiple arsons into a task-force known as Operation Backfire. Over the next years, two of the four suspects in the arson crime "family" were either arrested, or extradited to the United States, from countries where they had been in hiding. Only two suspects remain at large, and are still actively being sought by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, which issued a statement noting that Operation Backfire, will not be closed until the suspects are brought into custody.

The two individuals still at large are described as Josephine Sunshine Overaker –a white woman, approximately 37 years of age, five feet, three inches tall, and weighing 130 pounds., and Joseph Mahmoud Dibee, a white male of possible Syrian descent, approximately 44 years of age, six feet, three inches tall, and weighing 150 pounds. Josephine reportedly is also known as; Lisa Rachelle Quintana, Lisa R. Quintana, Maria Rachelle Quintana, Maria Quintana, "Osha", "Jo", "China", "Josie", or "Mo". Joseph is also known as; Joe Dibee, "Seattle", or "Steve".
