

Police in Sioux City, Iowa are currently seeking information on the whereabouts of Jamal Dean, a 22 year old who shot a police officer in the course of a traffic stop. The officer is expected to survive. The perpetrator used a rifle to shoot the officer, and then fled between the rows of houses, and melt into the night. Residents were advised to remain indoors, and temporarily area schools were placed on lockdown, although they were later reopened.

Jamal Dean is described as an African American male, standing six feet, 1 inch tall, and weighing 230 pounds. He is identifiable by a tattoo on the right side of his neck with the word "outlaw". Assisting in the investigation are officials from the U.S. Marshals. In addition to the shooting of the Sioux City Officer, Dean is also wanted for first-degree burglary and robbery, and second-degree theft. He should be considered armed and dangerous.



In the quiet Northern California suburb of Valley Springs, on April 27th, an intruder entered the home of a family, and proceed to stab an 8 year old girl multiple times, before fleeing the scene. The young girl died shortly afterward, with the young girl's twelve year old brother alerting the parents of the home to the attack and providing the description of the attacker to police who responded shortly afterward. In the hours that followed, the community was advised to lock their doors and stay inside, as police conducted searches of the neighboring areas, including going door to door. The suspect is described as a white or Hispanic male, last seen wearing a black long-sleeved shirt with blue pants. He is approximately six feet tall, with a muscular build and long gray hair. Residents of California are encouraged to report any information they may have regarding this suspect – Do not approach the individual, as he should be considered armed and dangerous.
